PSALMS 32:1

1 ¶ *A Psalm of David, Maschil. Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.*

PSALMS 32:2

2 *Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile.*

PSALMS 32:3

3 *When I kept silence, my bones waxed old through my roaring all the day long.*

PSALMS 32:4

4 *For day and night thy hand was heavy upon me: my moisture is turned into the drought of summer. Selah.*

PSALMS 32:5

5 *I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah.*

PSALMS 32:6

6 *For this shall every one that is godly pray unto thee in a time when thou mayest be found: surely in the floods of great waters they shall not come nigh unto him.*

PSALMS 32:7

7 ¶ *Thou art my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah.*

PSALMS 32:8

8 *I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye.*

PSALMS 32:9

9 *Be ye not as the horse, or as the mule, which have no understanding: whose mouth must be held in with bit and bridle, lest they come near unto thee.*

PSALMS 32:10

10 *Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that trusteth in the LORD, mercy shall compass him about.*

PSALMS 32:11

11 Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, ye righteous: and shout for joy, all ye *that are* upright in heart.
