4 In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me.

PSALMS 56:5

5 Every day they wrest my words: all their thoughts are against me for evil.

PSALMS 56:6

6 They gather themselves together, they hide themselves, they mark my steps, when they wait for my soul.

PSALMS 56:7

7 Shall they escape by iniquity? in *thine* anger cast down the people, O God.

PSALMS 56:8

8 Thou tellest my wanderings: put thou my tears into thy bottle: *are they* not in thy book?

PSALMS 56:9

9 When I cry *unto thee*, then shall mine enemies turn back: this I know; for God *is* for me.

10 In God will I praise *his* word: in the LORD will I praise *his* word.

PSALMS 56:11

11 In God have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do unto me.

PSALMS 56:12

12 Thy vows are upon me, O God: I will render praises unto thee.

13 For thou hast delivered my soul from death: *wilt* not *thou deliver* my feet from falling, that I may walk before God in the light of the living?
