5 ¶ For thou, O God, hast heard my vows: thou hast given *me* the heritage of those that fear thy name.

PSALMS 61:6

6 Thou wilt prolong the king's life: *and* his years as many generations.

PSALMS 61:7

7 He shall abide before God for ever: O prepare mercy and truth, *which* may preserve him.

PSALMS 61:8

8 So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, that I may daily perform my vows.
