1 ¶ A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah. O God, thou *art* my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;

PSALMS 63:2

2 To see thy power and thy glory, so as I have seen thee in the sanctuary.

PSALMS 63:3

3 Because thy lovingkindness *is* better than life, my lips shall praise thee.

PSALMS 63:4

4 Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name.

PSALMS 63:5

5 My soul shall be satisfied as *with* marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise *thee* with joyful lips:

PSALMS 63:6

6 When I remember thee upon my bed, and meditate on thee in the night watches.

PSALMS 63:7

7 ¶ Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice.

PSALMS 63:8

8 My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me.

PSALMS 63:9

9 But those *that* seek my soul, to destroy *it*, shall go into the lower parts of the earth.

10 They shall fall by the sword: they shall be a portion for foxes.

PSALMS 63:11

11 But the king shall rejoice in God; every one that sweareth by him shall glory: but the mouth of them that speak lies shall be stopped.
