2 Let my prayer be set forth before thee as incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.

PSALMS 141:3

3 Set a watch, O LORD, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips.

PSALMS 141:4

4 Incline not my heart to *any* evil thing, to practise wicked works with men that work iniquity: and let me not eat of their dainties.

PSALMS 141:5

5 ¶ Let the righteous smite me; *it shall be* a kindness: and let him reprove me; *it shall be* an excellent oil, *which* shall not break my head: for yet my prayer also *shall be* in their calamities.

PSALMS 141:6

6 When their judges are overthrown in stony places, they shall hear my words; for they are sweet.

PSALMS 141:7

7 Our bones are scattered at the grave's mouth, as when one cutteth and cleaveth *wood* upon the earth.

PSALMS 141:8

8 But mine eyes *are* unto thee, O GOD the Lord: in thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute.

9 Keep me from the snares *which* they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of iniquity.

PSALMS 141:10

10 Let the wicked fall into their own nets, whilst that I withal escape.
