III JOHN 1:1

1 ¶ The elder unto the wellbeloved Gaius, whom I love in the truth.

III JOHN 1:2

2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

III JOHN 1:3

3 ¶ For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth.

III JOHN 1:4

4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.

III JOHN 1:5

5 Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers;

III JOHN 1:6

6 Which have borne witness of thy charity before the church: whom if thou bring forward on their journey after a godly sort, thou shalt do well:

III JOHN 1:7

7 Because that for his name's sake they went forth, taking nothing of the Gentiles.

III JOHN 1:8

8 We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellowhelpers to the truth.

III JOHN 1:9

9 ¶ I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.

III JOHN 1:10

10 Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth *them* out of the church.

III JOHN 1:11

11 Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.

III JOHN 1:12

12 ¶ Demetrius hath good report of all *men*, and of the truth itself: yea, and we *also* bear record; and ye know that our record is true.

III JOHN 1:13

13 I had many things to write, but I will not with ink and pen write unto thee:

III JOHN 1:14

14 But I trust I shall shortly see thee, and we shall speak face to face. Peace *be* to thee. *Our* friends salute thee. Greet the friends by name.

JUDE 1

JUDE 1:1

1 ¶ Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, *and* called:

JUDE 1:2

2 Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied.

JUDE 1:3

3 ¶ Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort *you* that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

JUDE 1:4

4 For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

JUDE 1:5

5 I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.

JUDE 1:6

6 And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

JUDE 1:7

7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving

themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

JUDE 1:8

8 ¶ Likewise also these *filthy* dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

JUDE 1:9

9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

JUDE 1:10

10 But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.

JUDE 1:11

11 Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.

JUDE 1:12

12 These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds *they are* without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots;

JUDE 1:13

13 Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.

JUDE 1:14

14 And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,

JUDE 1:15

15 ¶ To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard *speeches* which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

JUDE 1:16

16 These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling *words*, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.

JUDE 1:17

17 But, beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ;

JUDE 1:18

18 How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.

JUDE 1:19

19 These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.

JUDE 1:20

20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

JUDE 1:21

21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

JUDE 1:22

22 And of some have compassion, making a difference:

JUDE 1:23

23 And others save with fear, pulling *them* out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

JUDE 1:24

24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present *you* faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

JUDE 1:25

25 To the only wise God our Saviour, *be* glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

REVELATION 1

REVELATION 1:1

1 ¶ The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified *it* by his angel unto his servant John:

REVELATION 1:2

2 Who bare record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of

all things that he saw.

REVELATION 1:3

3 ¶ Blessed *is* he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time *is* at hand.

REVELATION 1:4

4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from him which *is*, and which *was*, and which *is* to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;

REVELATION 1:5

5 And from Jesus Christ, *who is* the faithful witness, *and* the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

REVELATION 1:6

6 And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him *be* glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

REVELATION 1:7

7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they *also* which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

REVELATION 1:8

8 I *am* *Alpha* and *Omega*, the *beginning* and the *ending*, *saith* the *Lord*, *which is*, and *which was*, and *which is* to *come*, the *Almighty*.

REVELATION 1:9

9 ¶ I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

REVELATION 1:10

10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

REVELATION 1:11

11 Saying, I *am* *Alpha* and *Omega*, the *first* and the *last*: and, *What thou seest*, *write* in a *book*, and *send it* unto the *seven churches* *which are* in *Asia*; unto *Ephesus*, and unto *Smyrna*, and unto *Pergamos*, and unto *Thyatira*, and unto *Sardis*, and unto *Philadelphia*, and unto *Laodicea*.

REVELATION 1:12

12 And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;

REVELATION 1:13

13 And in the midst of the seven candlesticks *one* like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

REVELATION 1:14

14 His head and *his hairs were* white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes *were* as a flame of fire;

REVELATION 1:15

15 And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.

REVELATION 1:16

16 And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance *was* as the sun shineth in his strength.

REVELATION 1:17

17 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, *_Fear not; I _am the _first and the _last:*

REVELATION 1:18

18 *I am he that _liveth, and was _dead; and, _behold, I _am _alive for _evermore, _Amen; and _have the _keys of _hell and of _death.*

REVELATION 1:19

19 *_Write the things _which thou hast _seen, and the things _which are, and the things _which shall be _hereafter;*

REVELATION 1:20

20 *The _mystery of the _seven _stars _which thou _sawest in my _right hand, and the _seven _golden _candlesticks. The _seven _stars are the _angels of the _seven _churches: and the _seven _candlesticks _which thou _sawest are the _seven _churches.*
