

III JOHN 1

III JOHN 1:1

1 ¶ The elder unto the wellbeloved Gaius, whom I love in the truth.

III JOHN 1:2

2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

III JOHN 1:3

3 ¶ For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth.

III JOHN 1:4

4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.

III JOHN 1:5

5 Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers;

III JOHN 1:6

6 Which have borne witness of thy charity before the church: whom if thou bring forward on their journey after a godly sort, thou shalt do well:

III JOHN 1:7

7 Because that for his name's sake they went forth, taking nothing of the Gentiles.

III JOHN 1:8

8 We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellowhelpers to the truth.

III JOHN 1:9

9 ¶ I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.

III JOHN 1:10

10 Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth *them* out of the church.

III JOHN 1:11

11 Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.

III JOHN 1:12

12 ¶ Demetrius hath good report of all *men*, and of the truth itself: yea, and we *also* bear record; and ye know that our record is true.

III JOHN 1:13

13 I had many things to write, but I will not with ink and pen write unto thee:

III JOHN 1:14

14 But I trust I shall shortly see thee, and we shall speak face to face. Peace *be* to thee. *Our* friends salute thee. Greet the friends by name.

JUDE 1

JUDE 1:1

1 ¶ Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, *and* called:

JUDE 1:2

2 Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied.

JUDE 1:3

3 ¶ Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort *you* that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

JUDE 1:4

4 For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

JUDE 1:5

5 I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.

JUDE 1:6

6 And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

JUDE 1:7

7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving

themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

JUDE 1:8

8 ¶ Likewise also these *filthy* dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

JUDE 1:9

9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

JUDE 1:10

10 But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.

JUDE 1:11

11 Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.

JUDE 1:12

12 These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds *they are* without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots;

JUDE 1:13

13 Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.

JUDE 1:14

14 And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,

JUDE 1:15

15 ¶ To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard *speeches* which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

JUDE 1:16

16 These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling *words*, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.

JUDE 1:17

17 But, beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ;

JUDE 1:18

18 How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.

JUDE 1:19

19 These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.

JUDE 1:20

20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

JUDE 1:21

21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

JUDE 1:22

22 And of some have compassion, making a difference:

JUDE 1:23

23 And others save with fear, pulling *them* out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

JUDE 1:24

24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present *you* faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

JUDE 1:25

25 To the only wise God our Saviour, *be* glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

REVELATION 2

REVELATION 2:1

1 ¶ Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;

REVELATION 2:2

2 I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not

_bear them which are _evil: and thou hast _tried them which _say they are _apostles, and are not, and hast _found them _liars:

REVELATION 2:3

3 And hast _borne, and _hast _patience, and for my _name's sake hast _laboured, and hast not _fainted.

REVELATION 2:4

4 _Nevertheless I _have *somewhat* _against thee, _because thou hast _left thy _first _love.

REVELATION 2:5

5 _Remember _therefore from _whence thou art _fallen, and _repent, and _do the _first _works; _or _else I will _come unto thee _quickly, and will _remove thy _candlestick out of his _place, _except thou _repent.

REVELATION 2:6

6 But _this thou _hast, that thou _hatest the _deeds of the _Nicolaitans, _which I _also _hate.

REVELATION 2:7

7 He that _hath an _ear, let him _hear _what the _Spirit _saith unto the _churches; To him that _overcometh will I _give to _eat of the _tree of _life, _which is in the _midst of the _paradise of _God.

REVELATION 2:8

8 ¶ And unto the _angel of the _church in _Smyrna _write; _These things _saith the _first and the _last, _which was _dead, and is _alive;

REVELATION 2:9

9 I _know thy _works, and _tribulation, and _poverty, (but thou _art _rich) and I *know* the _blasphemy of them _which _say they are _Jews, and are not, but *are* the _synagogue of _Satan.

REVELATION 2:10

10 _Fear _none of _those things _which thou shalt _suffer: _behold, the _devil shall _cast *some* of you _into _prison, that ye may be _tried; and ye shall _have _tribulation _ten _days: be thou _faithful unto _death, and I will _give thee a _crown of _life.

REVELATION 2:11

11 He that _hath an _ear, let him _hear _what the _Spirit _saith unto the _churches; He that _overcometh shall not be _hurt of the _second _death.

REVELATION 2:12

12 ¶ And to the _angel of the _church in _Pergamos _write; _These things _saith he which _hath the _sharp _sword with _two _edges;

REVELATION 2:13

13 I _know thy _works, and _where thou _dwellest, *even* _where _Satan's _seat is: and thou _holdest fast my _name, and hast not _denied my _faith, _even in _those _days _wherein _Antipas was my _faithful _martyr, _who was _slain _among you, _where _Satan _dwelleth.

REVELATION 2:14

14 But I _have a _few things _against thee, _because thou _hast _there them that _hold the _doctrine of _Balaam, _who _taught _Balac to _cast a _stumblingblock _before the _children of _Israel, to _eat things _sacrificed unto _idols, and to _commit _fornication.

REVELATION 2:15

15 _So _hast thou _also them that _hold the _doctrine of the _Nicolaitans, _which thing I _hate.

REVELATION 2:16

16 _Repent; _or _else I will _come unto thee _quickly, and will _fight _against them with the _sword of my _mouth.

REVELATION 2:17

17 He that _hath an _ear, let him _hear _what the _Spirit _saith unto the _churches; To him that _overcometh will I _give to _eat of the _hidden _manna, and will _give him a _white _stone, and in the _stone a _new _name _written, _which _no _man _knoweth _saving he that _receiveth *it*.

REVELATION 2:18

18 ¶ And unto the _angel of the _church in _Thyatira _write; _These things _saith the _Son of _God, _who _hath his _eyes _like unto a _flame of _fire, and his _feet are _like fine _brass;

REVELATION 2:19

19 I _know thy _works, and _charity, and _service, and _faith, and thy _patience, and thy _works; and the _last *to be* _more than the _first.

REVELATION 2:20

20 _Notwithstanding I _have a _few things _against thee, _because thou _sufferest that _woman _Jezebel, _which _calleth _herself a _prophetess, to _teach and to _seduce my _servants to _commit _fornication, and to _eat things _sacrificed unto

_idols.

REVELATION 2:21

21 And I _gave her _space to _repent of her _fornication; and she _repented not.

REVELATION 2:22

22 _Behold, I will _cast her _into a _bed, and them that _commit _adultery with her _into _great _tribulation, _except they _repent of their _deeds.

REVELATION 2:23

23 And I will _kill her _children with _death; and _all the _churches shall _know that I _am he _which _searcheth the _reins and _hearts: and I will _give unto _every one of you _according to _your _works.

REVELATION 2:24

24 But unto you I _say, and unto the _rest in _Thyatira, as _many as _have not _this _doctrine, and _which have not _known the _depths of _Satan, as they _speak; I will _put upon you _none _other _burden.

REVELATION 2:25

25 _But that which ye _have *already* _hold fast _till I _come.

REVELATION 2:26

26 And he that _overcometh, and _keepeth my _works unto the _end, to him will I _give _power _over the _nations:

REVELATION 2:27

27 And he shall _rule them with a _rod of _iron; as the _vessels of a _potter shall they be _broken to _shivers: _even as I _received of my _Father.

REVELATION 2:28

28 And I will _give him the _morning _star.

REVELATION 2:29

29 He that _hath an _ear, let him _hear _what the _Spirit _saith unto the _churches.
