III JOHN 1

III JOHN 1:1

1 The elder unto the wellbeloved Gaius, whom I love in the truth.

III JOHN 1:2

2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

III JOHN 1:3

3 ¶ For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth.

III JOHN 1:4

4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.

III JOHN 1:5

5 Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers;

III JOHN 1:6

6 Which have borne witness of thy charity before the church: whom if thou bring forward on their journey after a godly sort, thou shalt do well:

III JOHN 1:7

7 Because that for his name's sake they went forth, taking nothing of the Gentiles.

III JOHN 1:8

8 We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellowhelpers to the truth.

III JOHN 1:9

9 ¶ I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.

III JOHN 1:10

10 Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth *them* out of the church.

III JOHN 1:11

11 Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.

III JOHN 1:12

12 ¶ Demetrius hath good report of all *men*, and of the truth itself: yea, and we *also* bear record; and ye know that our record is true.

III JOHN 1:13

13 I had many things to write, but I will not with ink and pen write unto thee:

III JOHN 1:14

14 But I trust I shall shortly see thee, and we shall speak face to face. Peace *be* to thee. *Our* friends salute thee. Greet the friends by name.

JUDE 1

JUDE 1:1

1 ¶ Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, *and* called:

JUDE 1:2

2 Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied.

JUDF 1:3

3 ¶ Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort *you* that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

JUDE 1:4

4 For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

JUDE 1:5

5 I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.

JUDE 1:6

6 And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

JUDE 1:7

7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving

themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

JUDE 1:8

8 Likewise also these *filthy* dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

JUDE 1:9

9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

JUDE 1:10

10 But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.

JUDE 1:11

11 Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.

JUDE 1:12

12 These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds *they are* without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots;

JUDE 1:13

13 Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.

JUDE 1:14

14 And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,

JUDE 1:15

15 To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

JUDE 1:16

16 These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling *words*, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.

JUDE 1:17

17 But, beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ;

JUDE 1:18

18 How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.

JUDE 1:19

19 These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.

JUDE 1:20

20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

JUDE 1:21

21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

JUDE 1:22

22 And of some have compassion, making a difference:

JUDE 1:23

23 And others save with fear, pulling *them* out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

JUDE 1:24

Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present *you* faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

JUDE 1:25

25 To the only wise God our Saviour, *be* glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

REVELATION 3:1

1 ¶ And unto the _angel of the _church in _Sardis _write; _These things _saith he that _hath the _seven _Spirits of _God, and the _seven _stars; I _know thy _works, that thou _hast a _name that thou _livest, and _art _dead.

REVELATION 3:2

2 Be _watchful, and _strengthen the things which _remain, that are _ready to _die:

for I have not _found thy _works _perfect _before _God.

REVELATION 3:3

3 _Remember _therefore _how thou hast _received and _heard, and _hold fast, and _repent. _If _therefore thou shalt _not _watch, I will _come _on thee as a _thief, and thou shalt not _know _what _hour I will _come upon thee.

REVELATION 3:4

4 Thou _hast a _few _names _even in _Sardis _which have not _defiled their _garments; and they shall _walk with me in _white: for they are _worthy.

REVELATION 3:5

5 He that _overcometh, the _same shall be _clothed in _white _raiment; and I will not _blot out his _name out of the _book of _life, but I will _confess his _name _before my _Father, and _before his _angels.

REVELATION 3:6

6 He that _hath an _ear, let him _hear _what the _Spirit _saith unto the _churches.

REVELATION 3:7

7 ¶ And to the _angel of the _church in _Philadelphia _write; _These things _saith he that is _holy, he that is _true, he that _hath the _key of _David, he that _openeth, and _no _man _shutteth; and _shutteth, and _no _man _openeth;

REVELATION 3:8

8 I _know thy _works: _behold, I have _set _before thee an _open _door, and _no _man _can _shut it: for thou _hast a _little _strength, and hast _kept my _word, and hast not _denied my _name.

REVELATION 3:9

9 _Behold, I will _make them of the _synagogue of _Satan, _which _say they are _Jews, and are not, but do _lie; _behold, I will _make them to _come and _worship _before thy _feet, and to _know that I have _loved thee.

REVELATION 3:10

10 _Because thou hast _kept the _word of my _patience, I _also will _keep thee from the _hour of _temptation, _which shall _come upon _all the _world, to _try them that _dwell upon the _earth.

REVELATION 3:11

11 _Behold, I _come _quickly: _hold that fast _which thou _hast, that _no _man _take thy _crown.

REVELATION 3:12

12 Him that _overcometh will I _make a _pillar in the _temple of my _God, and he shall _go _no _more out: and I will _write upon him the _name of my _God, and the _name of the _city of my _God, which is _new _Jerusalem, _which _cometh _down out of _heaven from my _God: and I will write upon him my _new _name.

REVELATION 3:13

13 He that _hath an _ear, let him _hear _what the _Spirit _saith unto the _churches.

REVELATION 3:14

14 And unto the _angel of the _church of the _Laodiceans _write; _These things _saith the _Amen, the _faithful and _true _witness, the _beginning of the _creation of _God;

16 _So then _because thou _art _lukewarm, and _neither _cold _nor _hot, I _will _spue thee out of my _mouth.

REVELATION 3:17

17 _Because thou _sayest, I _am _rich, and _increased with _goods, and _have _need of _nothing; and _knowest not that thou _art _wretched, and _miserable, and _poor, and _blind, and _naked:

REVELATION 3:18

18 I _counsel thee to _buy of me _gold _tried in the _fire, that thou mayest be _rich; and _white _raiment, that thou mayest be _clothed, and *that* the _shame of thy _nakedness do not _appear; and _anoint _thine _eyes with _eyesalve, that thou mayest _see.

REVELATION 3:19

19 As _many as I _love, I _rebuke and _chasten: be _zealous _therefore, and _repent.

REVELATION 3:20

20 _Behold, I _stand _at the _door, and _knock: _if _any man _hear my _voice, and _open the _door, I will _come in to him, and will _sup with him, and he with me.

REVELATION 3:21

21 To him that _overcometh will I _grant to _sit with me in my _throne, _even as I

_also _overcame, and am _set _down with my _Father in his _throne.

22 He that _hath an _ear, let him _hear _what the _Spirit _saith unto the _churches.
