III JOHN 1:1

1 ¶ The elder unto the wellbeloved Gaius, whom I love in the truth.

III JOHN 1:2

2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

III JOHN 1:3

3 ¶ For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth.

III JOHN 1:4

4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.

III JOHN 1:5

5 Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers;

III JOHN 1:6

6 Which have borne witness of thy charity before the church: whom if thou bring forward on their journey after a godly sort, thou shalt do well:

III JOHN 1:7

7 Because that for his name's sake they went forth, taking nothing of the Gentiles.

III JOHN 1:8

8 We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellowhelpers to the truth.

III JOHN 1:9

9 ¶ I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.

III JOHN 1:10

10 Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth *them* out of the church.

III JOHN 1:11

11 Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.

## III JOHN 1:12

12 ¶ Demetrius hath good report of all *men*, and of the truth itself: yea, and we *also* bear record; and ye know that our record is true.

## III JOHN 1:13

13 I had many things to write, but I will not with ink and pen write unto thee:

## III JOHN 1:14

14 But I trust I shall shortly see thee, and we shall speak face to face. Peace *be* to thee. *Our* friends salute thee. Greet the friends by name.

**JUDE 1**

## JUDE 1:1

1 ¶ Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, *and* called:

## JUDE 1:2

2 Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied.

## JUDE 1:3

3 ¶ Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort *you* that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

## JUDE 1:4

4 For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

## JUDE 1:5

5 I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.

## JUDE 1:6

6 And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

## JUDE 1:7

7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving

themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

JUDE 1:8

8 ¶ Likewise also these *filthy* dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

JUDE 1:9

9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

JUDE 1:10

10 But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.

JUDE 1:11

11 Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.

JUDE 1:12

12 These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds *they are* without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots;

JUDE 1:13

13 Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.

JUDE 1:14

14 And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,

JUDE 1:15

15 ¶ To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard *speeches* which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

JUDE 1:16

16 These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling *words*, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.

## JUDE 1:17

17 But, beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ;

## JUDE 1:18

18 How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.

## JUDE 1:19

19 These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.

## JUDE 1:20

20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

## JUDE 1:21

21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

## JUDE 1:22

22 And of some have compassion, making a difference:

## JUDE 1:23

23 And others save with fear, pulling *them* out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

## JUDE 1:24

24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present *you* faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

## JUDE 1:25

25 To the only wise God our Saviour, *be* glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

## REVELATION 3

## REVELATION 3:1

1 ¶ And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.

## REVELATION 3:2

2 Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die:

for I have not \_found thy \_works \_perfect \_before \_God.

#### REVELATION 3:3

3 \_Remember \_therefore \_how thou hast \_received and \_heard, and \_hold fast, and \_repent. \_If \_therefore thou shalt \_not \_watch, I will \_come \_on thee as a \_thief, and thou shalt not \_know \_what \_hour I will \_come upon thee.

#### REVELATION 3:4

4 Thou \_hast a \_few \_names \_even in \_Sardis \_which have not \_defiled their \_garments; and they shall \_walk with me in \_white: for they are \_worthy.

#### REVELATION 3:5

5 He that \_overcometh, the \_same shall be \_clothed in \_white \_raiment; and I will not \_blot out his \_name out of the \_book of \_life, but I will \_confess his \_name \_before my \_Father, and \_before his \_angels.

#### REVELATION 3:6

6 He that \_hath an \_ear, let him \_hear \_what the \_Spirit \_saith unto the \_churches.

#### REVELATION 3:7

7 ¶ And to the \_angel of the \_church in \_Philadelphia \_write; \_These things \_saith he that is \_holy, he that is \_true, he that \_hath the \_key of \_David, he that \_openeth, and \_no \_man \_shutteth; and \_shutteth, and \_no \_man \_openeth;

#### REVELATION 3:8

8 I \_know thy \_works: \_behold, I have \_set \_before thee an \_open \_door, and \_no \_man \_can \_shut it: for thou \_hast a \_little \_strength, and hast \_kept my \_word, and hast not \_denied my \_name.

#### REVELATION 3:9

9 \_Behold, I will \_make them of the \_synagogue of \_Satan, \_which \_say they are \_Jews, and are not, but do \_lie; \_behold, I will \_make them to \_come and \_worship \_before thy \_feet, and to \_know that I have \_loved thee.

#### REVELATION 3:10

10 \_Because thou hast \_kept the \_word of my \_patience, I \_also will \_keep thee from the \_hour of \_temptation, \_which shall \_come upon \_all the \_world, to \_try them that \_dwell upon the \_earth.

#### REVELATION 3:11

11 \_Behold, I \_come \_quickly: \_hold that fast \_which thou \_hast, that \_no \_man \_take thy \_crown.

## REVELATION 3:12

12 Him that *overcometh* will I *make a pillar* in the *temple* of my *God*, and he shall *go no more out*: and I will *write upon him the name of my God*, and the *name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God*: and *I will write upon him my new name*.

## REVELATION 3:13

13 He that *hath an ear*, let him *hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches*.

## REVELATION 3:14

14 ¶ And unto the *angel of the church of the Laodiceans write*; *These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God*;

## REVELATION 3:15

15 I *know thy works*, that thou *art neither cold nor hot*: I *would thou wert cold or hot*.

## REVELATION 3:16

16 *So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth*.

## REVELATION 3:17

17 *Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked*:

## REVELATION 3:18

18 I *counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire*, that thou mayest be *rich*; and *white raiment*, that thou mayest be *clothed*, and *that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear*; and *anoint thine eyes with eyesalve*, that thou mayest *see*.

## REVELATION 3:19

19 As *many as I love*, I *rebuke and chasten*: be *zealous therefore*, and *repent*.

## REVELATION 3:20

20 *Behold, I stand at the door, and knock*: *if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me*.

## REVELATION 3:21

21 To him that *overcometh* will I *grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I*

\_also \_overcame, and am \_set \_down with my \_Father in his \_throne.

REVELATION 3:22

22 He that \_hath an \_ear, let him \_hear \_what the \_Spirit \_saith unto the \_churches.
